

## A change is as good as a holiday

Stage 1 of refurbishments at Mantra Twin Towns will commence in February with a complete remodelling and brand new interior design throughout the Lobby level.

Interior designer Sue Jago from Split Watermelon Design, who has worked on many projects at Twin Towns including 1st on Wharf, Harbour Lounge and the Harbour Terrace balcony, said the new look would introduce "a real coastal vibe" to the Mantra Lobby.

"The design will bring a refreshing, bright and breezy coastal colour palette, with lots of whites, complemented by natural timbers and textures.

"There will be no doubt guests are stepping into a beachside resort when they walk through the doors of the Hotel," Sue said.

An air lock will be created at the front door of the

resort to protect the Lobby from wind and weather and optimise comfort for guests.

On Tuesday 29 January, the Mantra reception counter and lobby furniture will move to Terraces, directly opposite the current reception desk.

From Monday 4 February, Signatures buffet breakfast will move to Visions. Signatures dinner bookings will also cease from this date.

Major works, including the installation of a new reception counter and revamp of Signatures Cocktail Bar, will commence on Monday 4 February and are expected to take approximately 10 weeks.

It is anticipated the Lobby will be completed and breakfast will return to Signatures by Easter 2019.

Refurbishment of Mantra Twin Towns hotel rooms will commence later this year.

"Many older people are artists, athletes, business owners, farmers and volunteers, and this exhibition challenges people's perceptions."



Day trips start from Tweed City with a few stops along the Gold Coast Highway to Miami when travelling north and leave from Miami when travelling south. Extended trips leave from Twin Towns.

Trips coming up in 2019 include a day trip to Beenleigh Artisan Distillery on 4 February; a mystery trip on 25 February; a day trip to Brisbane on 4 March; and a Mount Tamborine Coffee Plantation tour on 25 March.

We are currently exploring some possible destinations for extended trips this year, such as Lightning Ridge and the Fraser Coast based at Hervey Bay. If we cannot get these destinations for the dates we have in mind, we have some other options we can investigate.
