BOARD  
CHAIRMAN'S  
REPORT

At last both the Federal and State elections have come and gone. The Club Industry remains in a good space, with any fears of a change of Government that may have disenfranchised the not-for-profit community Club Industry averted, allowing sustained confidence in the future.

Twin Towns Annual General Meeting and elections in May saw the three incumbent Directors returned comfortably by our voting members, providing continuity and confidence for the Board to fast-track our future planning to provide members with more improved facilities.

With talk of another Casino on the Gold Coast to replace many clubs, it's imperative that we build on our diversified income streams and look for opportunities to benefit members and secure a long-term future for our well-established community club.

There are always risks to business and Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts is no different, with the Board

conscious of the possibility of increased competition, greater regulation, Government policy shifts and last but not least, those hidden, increasing costs of running this large core business of gaming and hospitality.

It's incumbent upon the Board as caretakers of members and community assets to minimise risk and provide members with great facilities, along with a safe and secure operation as part of clubs' social licence.

Another extremely important aspect of club operations that one tends to overlook is the reliance on clubs, especially Twin Towns, to provide employment for residents of our Local Government area.

This employment translated to \$20.6 million of direct employment payments in 2018 which support our local economy and find their way back to businesses around Tweed Heads.

Not-for-profit community clubs are an essential part of the fabric of the community, returning all

profits to members' facilities and the community in our Local Government area.

Clubs employ vast numbers of qualified, skilled and well-trained staff. In addition, consultants, product suppliers, contractors and volunteers are all reliant on our Clubs both directly and indirectly.

Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts employs 296 staff, having been reduced from 382 with the transition to contract catering in a number of areas within the three Clubs.

In addition, Mantra Twin Towns resort and hotel has 81 staff, contract caterers 49, Kings Cleaning 17, Oasis Pools 15, Protex Security 10, Scotts House and Garden 7, Golf 3, HR Services 3, Compliance 1, Mackay hotel properties 16, making a total of 498 on-site staff the Club and community rely on within Twin Towns alone.

Include at least another 12 Clubs in the Tweed Local Government area and the many hotels that have specialist staff, it's fair to say that the hospitality industry plays an extremely important part in maintaining the Tweed Heads economy.

Bowling greens, tennis courts, swimming pools, golf courses, surf clubs, restaurants, coffee shops, bars, conference rooms, RSL Sub-Branch offices, other amenities and kids' areas, are all provided as part of the social licence for clubs

to operate to provide community and welfare facilities.

Taking on huge responsibilities, Twin Town's nine Directors have a Board tenure covering 162 years. It's quite a remarkable feat in this day and age, and shows their commitment, passion and dedication to Twin Towns members. Add to that our five extremely well-qualified management executives who make up a team with a combined total of 105 years of operation on behalf of members at Twin Towns, which certainly makes a statement about total dedication.

Good governance, due diligence and best practice principles will guide Twin Towns into the next generation, when providing for members and community and counteracting risk and threats to the business.

**Exceptional Staff Awards**

Recently, Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts hosted the ninth Club Staff Awards under the current recognition format at Sullivans Pioneer Country at South Tweed.

Unfortunately, all club facilities must remain operational, which limited attendance at this special event. Over 100 staff, managers and some Directors dressed in their best country and western attire and enjoyed a fantastic, mostly early night of fun, frivolity, games, good food and great country music at Pioneer Country.

Special thank you to staff who kept the home fires burning for

members and guests at the three Clubs and the resort while others partied on.

Despite this night being away from Twin Towns, for good reason, all those that attended had the opportunity to socialise with staff from other departments, banding together even outside a work environment as good friends do.

The Board acknowledge our dedicated and extremely loyal 296 staff with their fantastic work ethic, recognised by their peers in the industry. Providing this very special annual Staff Awards Night is part of that recognition and reward.

Since 2011, three or four staff annually have been recognised for their outstanding dedication and service above and consistently beyond business benchmarks, providing a standard for others to emulate.

These loyal staff selected by other staff, supervisors and management are recorded on Twin Towns Hall of Fame Roll.

This year Sam Collier, Gary Meekin, Marilyn Koffke and Simon Turley reached this pinnacle of recognition, deserving congratulations, and thank you for a remarkable journey.

Sam, Gary, Marilyn and Simon join 32 other amazing staff who have achieved this honour.

## Internal Club Pro-Rata Membership

Many members have asked for the convenience of aligning their internal club renewal month with the same month that their main club membership falls due.

The goal is that all the members fees fall due at the same time, reducing the need for multiple renewals throughout the year and the risk of forgetting to renew one of your many memberships.

A solution to this issue will be available from July to August 2019, where internal club members can make a pro-rata payment (part year payment) via their internal club committee.

Once the pro-rata fee is paid, your internal club membership will extend to the same month that your main membership falls due, therefore aligning the month of renewal for all your memberships.

This process is optional for those members who wish to align their memberships. It is not compulsory but is in response to a common concern.

If you are interested, please speak to your internal club representatives, who have been provided details of your corresponding pro-rata fee.

Pro-rata fees are payable to your internal club directly with the exception of Mens, Ladies and Vets Golf pro-rata membership payments which must be made via the Island House.


