TWIN TOWNS WELCOMES BACK ALL QUEENSLAND MEMBERS AND VISITORS FROM 1 OCTOBER

Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts are rolling out the welcome mat to an expected surge of members and visitors from Brisbane and beyond as the border towns take their first, tentative step towards the light at the end of the tunnel.

Whilst Gold Coasters living in the current border bubble can visit the Club anytime if they have a border pass, from Thursday 1 October, the Queensland side of the bubble no longer exists. This means ALL Queenslanders across the entire State can cross the border to Twin Towns and Mantra Twin Towns, provided they have a border pass.

Twin Towns CEO Rob Smith said that whilst they are cautiously optimistic this will be the first of many further relaxations of restrictions, he and the Board have learned how things can change, "in the blink of an eye".

"Moving forward will be dependent on the commitment of Twin Towns members and visitors to continue to abide by any COVIDSafe restrictions still in place. Everyone has a role to play in ensuring the border towns, and Tweed Clubs, remain safe, healthy and COVID-free environments for visitors."

Rob said any further relaxations of restrictions that have crippled the Clubs' operations over the past seven months, especially Twin Towns, are welcome to say the least.

"Many local clubs, restaurants, shops and businesses in Coolangatta-Tweed have also struggled under the weight of the border closure, restrictions on venues capacities and the additional costs involved in ensuring compliance with complex COVIDSafe rules and regulations.

"Let's not go backwards from here! For the time being, visitors to the Clubs still need to accept and abide by any restrictions that remain in place, such as social distancing, staying seated when enjoying a drink in the Clubs, and limits on venue capacities.

"We hope our next email to members delivers even more good news for us all ahead of the Christmas holiday season."

PRINT YOUR PASS

Those heading to Twin Towns from Queensland will still need a border pass to travel back across the border when they leave the Club. (See page 3.) Twin Towns has set up a computer and printer at main reception and staff can print your border pass if you wish to carry it with you.

DST IS BACK!



A reminder that Daylight Saving Time begins on Sunday 4 October and ends on Sunday 4 April 2021. During this time, Twin Towns (main Club at Tweed Heads) operates on Queensland time. Club Banora and Twin Towns Juniors operate on DST, or NSW time.

BOARD CHAIRMAN'S Report



I was not going to do a newsletter each month as nothing much was happening due to the restrictions put in place by various State governments.

The restrictions were imposed by governments, without any consultation with peak industry bodies or stakeholders. Due to the changes coming into effect at the end of September, I have decided to provide an update to keep our members fully aware of all changes which affect our Club and community.

The JobKeeper program finished on 28 September 2020 and a new set of qualifying rules and guidelines will be implemented by Government after this date. These new and tougher rules will be monitored and overseen by the ATO.

Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts did not qualify for JobKeeper 2.0 due to the stricter conditions imposed by these changes. This has significantly impacted on the way we do business and look after our members, staff and the community in general. This decision has also created confusion amongst our team of dedicated employees, who through no fault of their own, may have their hours of work reduced and their income decreased. Some, unfortunately, will not be able to be retained by Twin Towns and our thoughts are with them during this difficult time.

The number of patrons visiting our premises has diminished dramatically due to the border closures and the spread of Covid19, although not many cases were diagnosed in our catchment area. The southern nomads who usually hibernate in our area during the winter months, did not arrive due to the problems with the virus in their own State and we wish them well.

The Board and Executive Management have put together a plan that will ensure Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts continues to be the place to go for a very special occasion or a day or night out with family and friends. The plan implemented on 28 September 2020 will not please everybody as some areas of our properties will be closed for the foreseeable future. The areas affected are as follows:

TWIN TOWNS:

Signatures Bar will close.
Flame Café will close.
Flame Pizzeria will operate from Wednesday to Sunday only.
Events will close and not accept bookings.
Showroom closed to future bookings (excluding those currently on sale)
Membership will open Monday to Friday only with limited hours.
Show tickets will move to online only.

CLUB BANORA:

Island House will close.

The Board is very thankful to our very professional management team and all our staff, led by CEO Rob Smith, who have worked tirelessly guiding us through a difficult and challenging period. These decisions made were not taken lightly but had to be made for the benefit of the Club and the community. The road ahead will not be easy but I am sure this great Club will be well-positioned for the future.

Please continue to support your Clubs, adhering to all the health guidelines which are in place during your visit. Please respect our staff as they are only doing their job trying to keep you safe on our premises.



LINKWAY REOPENS

The covered overhead linkway between the multi-level carpark, Mantra Twin Towns Resort and the main Club, Twin Towns, has reopened. Easy access to the Club is now available for resort guests and those who park on the Mantra side of Twin Towns. After you cross the linkway, take the lift to the ground floor and sign in at the atrium.

Entry to the multi-level carpark is via Stuart Street. No need to worry about the weather – it's undercover all the way from your car to the Club.



UPDATE YOUR DETAILS TO WIN AN IPAD

Update your contact details in your Twin Towns membership records before Wednesday 28 October and go in the draw to win a 6th Generation 32MB Apple iPad. If your contact details are up to date, you're automatically in the draw.

If you want to update or check your contact details, here's what you need to do:

1. Install the Twin Towns App on your mobile or iPad and register as a member. Check your mobile and email details are correct and if not, you can change them.

THE BORDER BUBBLE JUST GOT BIGGER

Twin Towns and Mantra Twin Towns Resort are physically located just a few metres south of the Queensland/New South Wales border so you will be entering New South Wales when you visit the Club or Resort.

The latest relaxation of border restrictions from 1 October allows all Queenslanders to cross the border, provided they remain in the NSW side of the bubble, which now extends to the Byron, Ballina, Lismore, Richmond Valley and Glenn Innes shires.

Queenslanders who meet the eligibility criteria can cross the border to Twin Towns but they must download a border pass and carry it with them, or keep on their car dashboard or phone.

There are a few easy steps to follow to download a border pass. Hundreds of eligible residents travel over the border to Twin Towns every day, for lunch or dinner, a night out or to catch up with family and friends. All Queensland residents can now stay at [Mantra Twin Towns](#) if they have their pass.

If you're walking over the border to Twin Towns, you will need to have your border pass with you to travel back through the checkpoint when you return to Queensland.

If you have any questions, it's always best to contact the relevant State Health Department.

STEP 1

Go to the [Qld Health Website](#) for the latest maps including changes to the border bubble.

STEP 2

If you're in the bubble and meet the [requirements](#), download a [Qld Border Declaration pass](#) for each person travelling here.

STEP 3

Keep an up-to-date copy in your car, on your phone or make sure it's with you at all times if you're walking. Be sure to keep up with any changes to border crossing restrictions as they occur.

TWEED LOCALS

Those living south of the border, in fact, anywhere in New South Wales, are welcome at the Club and can stay at the Resort.

Tweed Heads, South Tweed, Banora Point and Kingscliff residents are all border pass eligible so they can cross the border into Queensland too if they wish.

Just a reminder, you will be in New South Wales while you are visiting Twin Towns and the Resort. However, downloading a border pass is free, easy and an added bonus for locals! So if you'd like to wander to the beach during your stay, simply download your pass.

Tweed locals have continued to make the most of the regular Club facilities at Twin Towns' two local Clubs - Club Banora at Banora Point and Twin Towns Juniors at Tweed Heads South. Both Clubs have become popular local hubs for dining, socialising and watching sport on the big screens in a friendly, relaxed, COVIDSafe environment.


Management implores those attending to ensure they abide by Public Health Orders in place at the time of the performances and adhere to instructions issued by COVIDSafe Marshals on the day.


