Holding our massive ham raffles at the Clubs a couple of days each week was also likely to pose similar problems with exceeding venue capacities.

So, this year the Board decided to combine the two.

As a bonus for members, all they need to do for a ticket in the ham raffles is visit any of the Clubs, from now until the final draw date, and swipe their card when they make a qualifying purchase at any bar till. It could be for a beer, wine or soft drink.

Just one single purchase gives you a Christmas Ham Raffle Mania ticket and the chance to share in almost \$11,000 worth of hams. Entry in the draw is automatic.

Members can celebrate Christmas with family and friends at their leisure at the Clubs during December and still be part of the fun. There are more ways to earn tickets so ask one of the friendly staff how to boost your chances.

A total of 270 hams will be given away over three weeks. The draws will be silent; winning members will be notified and can collect their ham from their nominated Club.

Despite the difficult times we have all faced this year, Christmas will always be a time for giving at your Clubs and we're trying to adapt within the rules to ensure we do our part.

# **NEW YEAR'S EVE FOR MEMBERS**

THE YEAR OF DOING THINGS DIFFERENTLY IS SET TO CONTINUE UNTIL THE VERY LAST DAY OF 2020 AND HOPEFULLY NOT TOO FAR BEYOND!

At the time of publication, venue capacities and COVIDSafe restrictions are still in place, limiting the Club's ability to welcome the huge crowds that regularly flock to Twin Towns and the border for New Year's Eve each year.

Recent events at the Club including Melbourne Cup Day highlighted the issues posed by venue capacity limits. Those planning to visit Twin Towns on New Year's Eve are advised that once venue capacity limits are reached, patrons may need to queue or be a member to enter the Club. Waiting times could be lengthy as it is unlikely many patrons will exit the Club before midnight.

Once in the Club, please follow instructions issued by Twin Towns COVIDSafe Marshalls as social distancing measures will be in place. Patrons will be required to stay seated in their designated zone while having a drink and unfortunately, dancing will not be permitted.

Whilst Twin Towns would certainly like to bring you all the bells and whistles for New Year's Eve at the Clubs, sadly it won't be the case this year unless there are significant changes to the current rules.

Nonetheless, there are more reasons than ever to celebrate a brand new year in a safe and happy environment. Despite the challenges, it will still be the time to crack open a bottle of champagne, toast to good health, family and friends, and let's leave 2020 in our wakes.

#### NYE at Club Banora & Twin Towns Juniors

Oasis Pools New Year's Eve party at Club Banora cannot be held this year due to COVIDSafe restrictions. The outdoor children's playground at Club Banora will also be closed.

If you are planning to attend Banora or Juniors on New Year's Eve, once venue capacities are reached there may be queues or you may need to be a member to enter.



The year has gone so quickly and a lot of things have happened. I am not going to dwell on the pandemic which we have endured and fortunately, without much assistance from government, managed to come through mostly unscathed.

Twin Towns Juniors and Club Banora have performed reasonably well during the 12 months. Unfortunately, Twin Towns was severely impacted by the restrictions on the holding of events and shows, which I can't see improving in the near future.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our members for supporting your Club throughout the year. You all made a difference which assisted in keeping the doors open and the lights on.

I know it was difficult remembering all the restrictions placed on you while at our premises and you should be congratulated for the manner in which you conducted yourselves. I know I was informed on several occasions that I had to be seated whilst drinking and was not allowed to mingle, which I found very difficult. Let's hope all will be back to some form of normality in the near future.

To all of our internal clubs, a few who have still not resumed their normal activities, thank you for your patience and understanding of restrictions imposed by difficult circumstances. You have done everything asked of you and in some cases more.

This year we were unable to hold our November consultative meeting due to restrictions but you can be assured we will have a meeting as soon as possible, perhaps early next year. I will keep you informed. There have been a number of improvements programmed for Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts and I would like to keep you updated on their progress or lack thereof.

The first is the retail development at Club Banora. At the present time, the Development Application is with Council and we are looking towards a positive outcome in the not to distant future. The changes to the Club Banora footprint are also with Council, as both Development Applications run concurrently as decisions will include both projects.

The D.A. for First on Wharf Tavern has been approved and the renovation will commence early next year. The changes include raising the driveway to a similar height as the footpath, opening the entrance way and using awnings to identify access. Windows will also be installed along the front wall to allow natural light into the bar area.

These changes will make the area more appealing to pedestrians passing by and also allow direct street access. I am sure you will appreciate the difference these changes will make.

The D.A. for the rear balcony overlooking Jack Evans Boat Harbour has been placed on public exhibition on the Council website and has sought public comment before approval of the application. We don't know how long this will take.

This Christmas will be entirely different to the festivities we held and celebrated in the past. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our members for the support you have given to the Board and Management during this difficult period. We can only look forward with a positive outlook for the future.

To you and your families, we wish you all a very merry Christmas and a safe and prosperous New Year. As you gather with families and friends in celebration, please spare a thought for those members of the community less fortunate than we are.

Don't forget to cash in your points before 24 December as all points are purged at midnight on Christmas Eve.

## HOLIDAY SNAPSHOTS LIGHT UP THE TWEED FOR CHRISTMAS

A SPECIAL PRESENTATION OF VIDEOS AND IMAGES OF SUMMER HOLIDAYS AND BEACH SCENES OF YESTERYEAR WILL LIGHT UP THE 17 METRE BY FIVE METRE ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE TWIN TOWNS BUILDING IN DECEMBER AND JANUARY.

Rare beach photos from the early 1900s up to the 1960s, including holiday crowds camping, swimming and competing in the Hokey Pokey dance and beauty competitions, have been generously provided by the Tweed Regional Museum.

A collection of stills and moving images captured by local photographer Charles Simpson in the 1940s and 1950s which were donated to the Museum by the Simpson family, and a selection of clips filmed around Tweed Heads in the 1950s and 60s, will also bring local history to life for all to enjoy.

The lightshow can be seen on screen from 18 December to 10 January, on the hour from 7.10pm QLD.
