# Marty Thompson returns to Twin Towns in new role

Last month, Twin Towns welcomed back Marty Thompson, a familiar face around the Clubs having previously been the Salvation Army's Club Chaplain for the past two and a half years.

Marty has taken up a new role as Twin Towns Staff & Customer Service Ambassador, a role created due to proposed changes to the Gaming Amendment (Gaming Harm Minimisation) Bill 2020 and legislation coming into effect from 1 July 2021.

Changes to the Bill are designed to improve management and intervention by gambling venues to support people who show problematic gambling behaviours and offer support tools including counselling and advisory services and self-exclusion.

Marty's role is to effectively manage crisis situations and provide support to staff who are tasked with dealing with difficult customer interactions.

Marty said he's excited to take up the role at Twin Towns and is looking forward to once again providing support to the members and staff at our various clubs.

"I am committed to assisting Twin Towns in their desire to promote the health and wellbeing of members, visitors and staff where possible.

"If members have any concerns about their gambling or a family member who is displaying signs of problem gambling, please feel free to contact me to discuss possible strategies, resources and referrals to address these issues," said Marty.

## NED KELLY COMES TO LIFE ON THE BIG SCREEN AT TWIN TOWNS

Following the recent 2020 Archibalds Prize lightshow on the huge 17 metre screen on the exterior of Twin Towns, Tweed Regional Gallery & Margaret Olley Art Centre is once again helping Twin Towns light up the Tweed skyline with a selection of famous Sidney Nolan paintings.

The latest lightshow from the Gallery's upcoming exhibition, The Ned Kelly series by Sidney Nolan, can be seen each night from 15 March to 4 April, on the hour every hour from 7.10pm to 11.10pm Qld.

Art buffs will be familiar with the artworks painted by Nolan between 1946 and 1947. Bushranger Ned Kelly is the theme, and the collection is considered one of the greatest series of Australian paintings of the 20th century.

The Ned Kelly series is a distillation of a complex, layered story set in the Victorian landscape and centred around a 19th century bushranger and his gang who were on the run from the police.

In the words of Sidney Nolan, "It began in the landscape and ended in the landscape".

# Always **improving facilities** at Twin Towns

*A major factor in the Twin Towns' success story has been the long-term commitment by successive Boards over many decades to ensuring renovations, maintenance and upgrades continually enhance, improve or increase the Clubs' facilities and appeal to members.*

Over the past challenging 12 months for Twin Towns, the Board has taken the opportunity to plan and gain approval for two projects designed to enhance existing favourite features at the main club.

Works are currently underway at 1st on Wharf Tavern, and construction of an extension to the Harbour Terrace balcony will commence in May.

Your Club is set to become a hive of activity, with our regular group of local tradies and contractors relishing the opportunities these upgrades will bring to the Tweed! Many local companies will also supply a raft of building products required for the works.

## 1st on Wharf Tavern

Work commenced in February on renovations at 1st on Wharf, including remodelling the lane and entryway to improve access to the Tavern and TAB, especially for people with mobility impairments.

Large picture windows will be installed alongside the current entry to the Tavern, increasing the flow of natural light and allowing a picture view from indoors to outside.

A new seating configuration along the first tier near the existing drinking rail will allow more people to enjoy a better view of the Tavern's 5.4 metre wide by 2 metre high mega screen.

The Tavern will have a new, all-weather entry from Wharf Street, with automatic-opening doors, features management



realised were lacking in the original design.

A previous Development Application which was approved along with the big screen on the exterior of Twin Towns will now be actioned, and a new sound system installed to provide audio to accompany

the light shows on the building at night.

The Tavern project comes at a cost of \$350,000 and expected completion date is mid-April.

The plans will make this 'gem' of a meeting place even more appealing.

## Harbour Terrace Balcony extension & upgrade

A Development Application has been approved by Tweed Shire Council and works will commence in May on an extension of the Harbour Terrace balcony and remodelling of the existing outdoor area at the rear of Twin Towns.

The new area will become an open space where members can relax outdoors and

appreciate the expansive views over Jack Evans Boat Harbour, the Tweed River and beyond.

CEO Rob Smith said when the balcony first opened in 2012, it was accessible to all.

"When changes to the smoking laws were implemented in 2015, food service was no longer allowed on the balcony

because it was designated for smokers.

"Since then, we have received regular feedback from non-smokers who also wanted to enjoy the outdoor space.

"The new extension will add an additional 140 square metres, so outdoor dining will once again be possible and there will be space for smokers and non-smokers.

"It's a win-win all round, a solution we hope will put smiles on the faces of all members who want to enjoy a drink and a meal overlooking one of Twin Towns best assets - the harbour views," said Rob.

Some areas of the Harbour Lounge may be impacted during the construction where we are also planning a new bar to provide better direct service to the balcony as well. See April Club News for more updates.

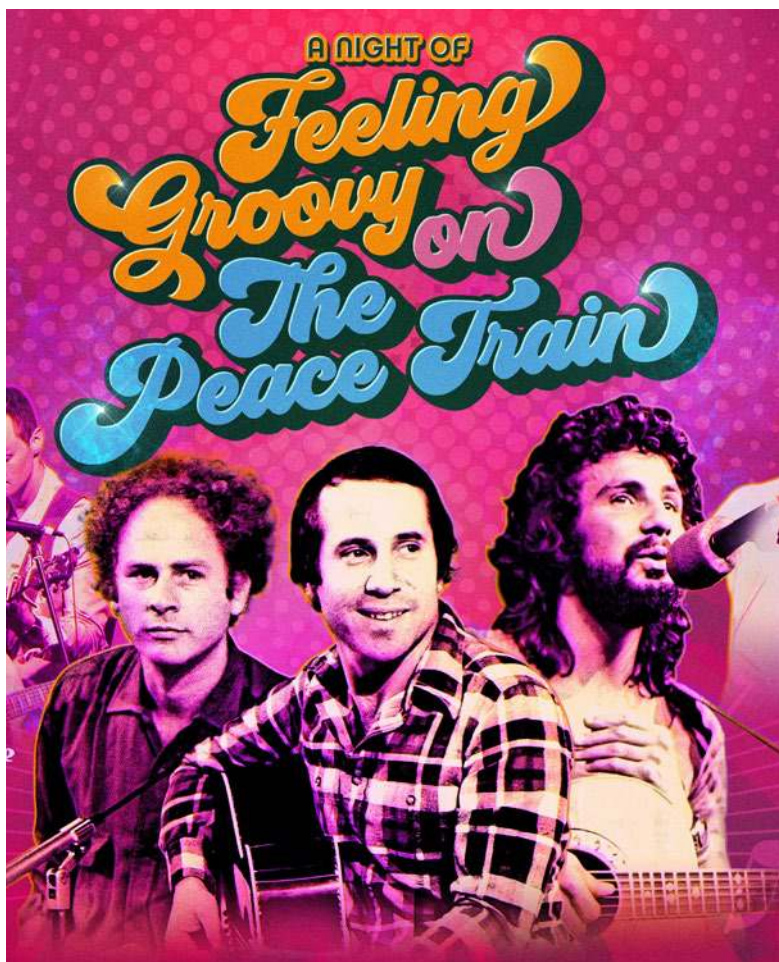

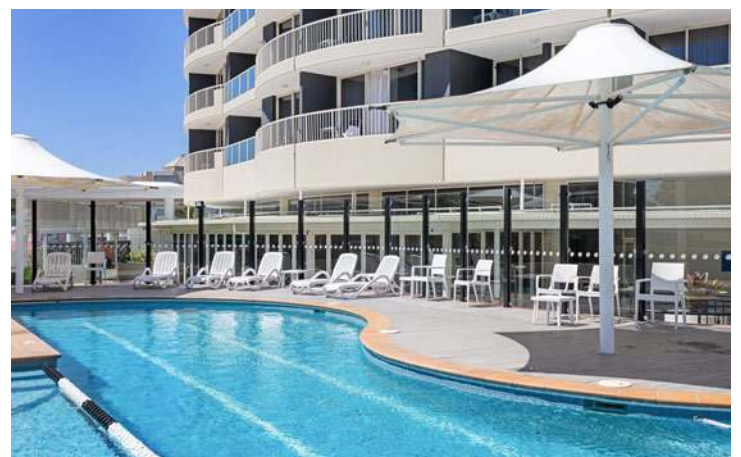

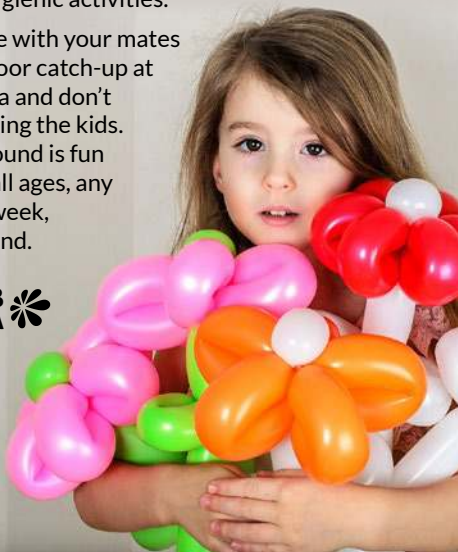
