A LEAFY OUTDOOR CLASSROOM THANKS TO CLUBGRANTS

AFTER A THREE-YEAR QUEST, SPECIAL
EDUCATION TEACHER & PROJECT
COORDINATOR BRIDIE BEARD SAID TWIN
TOWNS AND TWEED CLUBGRANTS HAVE
BROUGHT DREAMS TO LIFE FOR STUDENTS AND
TEACHERS AT BANORA POINT HIGH SCHOOL.

The school received a grant of \$47,500 through ClubGRANTS Category 2 funding, which allowed them to build an inclusive, engaging and stimulating outdoor environment for students with disabilities and special learning and sensory needs.

The ClubGRANTS funding included \$27,500 from Twin Towns, \$10,000 from South Tweed Sports and \$9,000 from Cabarita Beach Bowls & Sports Club.

After the Twin Towns Board of Directors saw first-hand the passion and commitment for the project shown by the teachers and masterminds behind it, Twin Towns chipped in an additional \$10,500 from its philanthropic arm, the Twin Towns Services Community Foundation.

Bridie said that when she received notification that Twin Towns had donated \$27,500 for our inclusive outdoor classroom, she was elated.

"Then I got the next one, and the next one. Three Tweed Clubs contributed, as well as Twin Towns Services Community Foundation, so all up we received \$57,000.

"I still get goose bumps when I say that out loud."

One of the most expensive aspects of the project, and one of the most important, was laying over 250 square metres of concrete. This has allowed inclusive access to 12 new raised garden beds which hold a range of targeted and edible sensory plants.

Bridie's students at Banora Point High School now have the opportunity to develop work-ready skills and learn in an authentic, hands-on environment across a wide scope of the Life Skills curriculum.

Twin Towns Deputy Chairman David Phillips said he hopes that when members read this story and learn that these kids now have the tools to grow, harvest and cook their own organic food, they find it heart-warming.

"All Twin Towns members and members of Clubs right across the Tweed have contributed to this project.

"Whether its by way of their annual membership, supporting their Club through visitation, dining out or seeing a show, this is what makes it possible for Tweed Clubs to make these worthwhile donations and support their communities," said David.

my number was 11, my lucky number, I just knew.


"I started shaking and crying before the final draw had even taken place.


"When I was announced as the winner, I yelled, screamed, fell on the floor and rolled around," Louise laughed.

SHOW TICKET PURCHASES AT THE DESK

Thankfully, Twin Towns has moved on from the years of Covid-19 disruptions - border closures, shutdowns and cancellations, and the havoc it wreaked on our entertainment program from 2020 to the early part of 2022.

One of the most troubling legacies to arise in the wake of the pandemic, for Twin Towns and clubs and pubs across the country, has been staff shortages.

To cope with extra demands on existing staff, the Club has had to make many changes and modifications to opening times across many areas of the Club.


Workload for the Twin Towns Membership Desk team has also increased and has been exacerbated by over-the-counter and phone bookings.

The Board has decided to increase the administration fee for bookings not made online to \$10 per transaction. Unlike other ticketing platforms such as Ticketmaster and Ticketek who charge an administration fee for each ticket transaction, Twin Towns will charge the \$10 one-off fee for multiple ticket purchases or multiple show bookings.

The fee will be introduced from 1 February 2023. Tickets purchased at the Membership Desk or over the phone for shows after this date will incur the administration fee.

Members and visitors who wish to book show tickets are encouraged to book online, which incurs a \$2.75 administration fee (morning melodies) and \$4.95 administration fee (all other shows) per transaction.

And remember, there are also over 120 hours of free live entertainment to enjoy every month with bands, duos and soloists performing at Twin Towns and another 16 hours at Club Banora.




