The 65th Annual General Meeting of Twin Towns Services Club Limited was held on 17 May 2022. On the night, the 126 members who attended enjoyed supper and refreshments at the conclusion of the meeting.

The meeting was conducted under the new format for modern AGM's. It was a little different to the usual format but I am sure this will improve as more members become familiar with the requirements into the future.

A ballot was not required to elect the three directors as required under the Club's Constitution as there was no other nominees. The successful nominees are as follows: David Phillips, John Griffin and Ken Culpitt. Congratulations on being returned for another three years.

There were several other orders of business dealt with including the adoption of a new Constitution. This was adopted unanimously by the members present.

The name change proposed was defeated by the members and we respect their decision as we move forward. There were no other questions received in general business and the meeting concluded at 7.38 pm.

#### TWIN TOWNS CONSTITUTION

An important change in the new Constitution is one that all members should be aware of. It relates to the 'Giving of Notices'.

Members who are not familiar with this change can visit the Twin Towns <u>website</u> and <u>login</u> via the Members portal to view the new Constitution in its entirety; in particular, Section 40 – Notices, Meetings and Voting - Requirements and Facilitation.

Under mandatory requirements of legislation under the Corporations Act and legislation applying to NSW Registered Clubs, notices of meetings, voting, or other notices or documents or information must be provided to members in a timely manner.

The recent change to the Constitution allows the Club to supply documents or information to members via electronic means chosen by Twin Towns including, where permissible under the legislation, a link to the notice, document or information which can be viewed or downloaded.

Providing information to members electronically not only allows them immediate access, the document will also be readily accessible for future reference.

Although members may elect to receive documents in hard copy, I strongly encourage all members to continue to receive information from the Club electronically.

Important Club communications relating to members meetings are always issued via email and are also available by logging into the members portal on the <a href="Twin">Twin</a> Towns website.

Full Members (Ordinary and Life Members) who wish to receive Meeting Notices and/or Annual Reports in hard copy must notify the Club's Secretary in writing. Once this has occurred, you will then receive the information addressed to the mailing address in our membership records

Now more than ever, it is important for all members to provide an email address as their chosen form of communication with Twin Towns. If you have already recorded your email address on your membership details, it is equally important to ensure it is up to date.

A member is deemed to have received a notice, document or information the day after it is sent. This applies even if the member does not receive the information; or the Club, having sent to the member's registered email address, receives an error message.

Section 40 of the Constitution also allows the Club to livestream meetings online including an Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) or Annual General Meeting (AGM) at any stage, if the Board decides to do so.

Thank you to our members for approving this change to the Constitution which will allow Twin Towns to significantly reduce the environmental impacts, and costs, of print and postage.



An artist's view brings together interiors and still life paintings by Margaret Olley and works by contemporary artists who have taken inspiration from Margaret Olley, her practice and her famous


Duxford Street home studio. Including painting, photography and works on paper, the exhibition presents different artist's views and responses to her still life and interior subjects.






