



# A BRAND NEW CHAPTER FOR JUNIORS

TWENTY YEARS ON SINCE TWIN TOWNS TOOK OVER JUNIORS AT SOUTH TWEED AND GOT THE FINANCIALLY STRUGGLING CLUB BACK ON ITS FEET, A BRAND NEW AND EXCITING CHAPTER IS SET TO UNFOLD EARLY NEXT YEAR.

The Development Application has been approved and the construction of a new, elevated Clubhouse will commence in March. The project is expected to cost around \$10M.

Although preliminary designs favoured a modular construction because of a reduced build time, it became apparent that this

would mean some critical limitations including ceiling height.

During the planning and approvals stages of the project, the overall costs for the design dramatically increased but the Board resolved that the redevelopment is so important it must proceed as soon as possible.

Juniors has already suffered flood damage on two occasions this year alone and the Board decided "enough is enough".

The Club is now engaging with Tweedbased TLF Developments to refine the design and look at other quick build concepts which meet the design criteria.

TLF Developments have carried out numerous projects at Twin Towns, including the refurbishment of five floors of hotel rooms, the reception and Lobby Bar at the Resort, renovations at 1st on Wharf Tavern and most recently, the Harbour Terrace Balcony.

Although the build time will take a little longer at approximately 30 weeks, it will ensure the critical elements of height, light and clear open spaces can be delivered.

CEO Rob Smith said that TLF Developments and their tradies have developed a trusted working relationship with the Club and their design team.

"We know TLF have a great work ethic and their workmanship is of a high standard.

"Another key factor is that TLF use local sub-contractors and suppliers, which will ensure money spent by Twin Towns on the Juniors project stays local," said Rob.

Taking into account likely material delays experienced across the building industry, once a contract is agreed, TLF and Twin Towns will commence a three-month procurement period from December.

This will ensure all materials and equipment are ordered and stored for when work begins on the project in March.

Flooding issues which have plagued the Club for more than a decade will become a thing of the past, with the new design ensuring the Club will be flood-safe all year round. Although the Clubhouse will be contemporary in its design, everything that currently works well and members enjoy most will be modernised and refreshed, including the outdoor area and beer garden.

For more than six decades, Twin Towns' long-term strategy of investing, reinvesting and growing the organisation, its Clubs, its assets, services and facilities for members, has been paramount to the success of the organisation.

This strategy continues to evolve as the plans roll out for a new Juniors Club in 2023.

The Board has recognised the impending closure of Juniors for redevelopment in March means many members will sorely miss catching up and socialising at their local.

As the saying goes, time flies, and before we know it, the doors will be opening to a brand new contemporary-styled Juniors Club around September/October 2023.

locals well-informed on the progress and timelines.

Transport alternatives between Juniors and Club Banora may be an option during the shutdown period but this is yet to be determined.

If any of the major draw winners are not present to claim their cash in August, the prize will carry over to September for what could become a 'bumper' draw!



Last month, Circus Quirkus rolled into town and thanks to Twin Towns, an additional 63 local kids got the chance to see an eclectic and wildly entertaining mix of clowns, jugglers and death-defying acrobatics.

Around 2,200 children were able to enjoy the event, through the live show at SOPO (Southport RSL) and the streamed version. This year marks the 30th anniversary of this annual event hosted by the Broadwater Southport Rotary Club.

Circus Quirkus has become a highlight of the year for disadvantaged and special needs children from all over the Gold Coast and Tweed.

This year, kids from Shaping Outcomes at Tweed, ACT for Kids and 17 kids nominated by the Department of Communities and Justice were able to attend thanks to Twin Towns.

Anna McLachlan from Broadwater Southport Rotary Club said she put in a late call to Twin Towns when just days before the show, many Tweed kids were still on a waitlist, pending funding to cover the costs. "Twin Towns jumped on board at the last minute and kindly donated \$3780 which covered 63 Tweed children to attend.

"The last few years, the show has been streamed rather than a live performance because of the pandemic.

"The upside was it reached kids in hospitals and regional areas and the opportunity to watch it in the comfort of their own homes worked well for some children on the spectrum who don't cope well in crowd settings," said Anna.

Along with the live show, it was streamed again this year for these special kids but those who were there were so excited to have their live show back.

Proceeds raised from this event support the Children's Critical Care Unit at Gold Coast University Hospital.

The Twin Towns Board of Directors were pleased to be able to give local kids the chance to go to this amazing event and hope all those who saw it, and their families, had a fantastic time.

### TINNIES FOR SCHOOLS OR COMMUNITY GROUPS

## BANORA BOYS GRAB NATIONAL BILLIARDS GLORY

Congratulations to Twin Towns Club Banora Snooker iunior players Christiano De Azevedo and Cooper Thomson who made history at the Under 16 Australian National Junior Championships in Albury last month.

Twin Towns Club Banora now has its first national title in Billiards, with 15-year-old Christiano De Azevedo taking out the championship.



The achievement was even more impressive for the Club as Christiano played the final against his fellow Club Banora junior member, Cooper Thomson.

Cooper qualified for the semifinals in top spot and Christiano in third spot. This kept them apart for the semi-final matches but the two boys had battling wins

through the heats to set up the all-Banora final.

Cooper had already beaten Christiano in the group stage by 177-128 and was considered a slight favourite but it was the final result that counted.


The final went for 90 minutes, with Cooper ahead for the first 60 minutes before Christiano gradually gained control and built up a lead that he kept all the way to the buzzer. Final score was 246 - 192 for Christiano.

As well as the first ever **Billiards National Champion** for the club, Christiano also became only the fourth Twin Towns Banora member to win a National title after Snooker titles for Craig Duffy, Megan Fullerton and Jessica Woods.

This was the boys' second visit to Albury thanks to Twin Towns Services Community Foundation, the Club's philanthropic association set up to provide financial assistance to local community and sporting groups, charitable organisations and causes.

The Foundation proudly sponsored Cooper and Christiano again this year, contributing \$1,650 towards their airfares and accommodation.


# THOMPSON TWINS TOM BAILEY




