There has been a lot going on in the Club after a terrible couple of years dealing with Covid and all the issues involved with making sure workers and members of the public were kept safe and updated with the latest information available at all times.

The emergency has finally been contained but not eradicated.

We will have to remain vigilant as we return to our normal way of life that will never be the same as it was previously. The last couple of months have gone very quickly and the end of the year is fast approaching. Before we know it, Christmas will be upon us.

As you return to the Club you will probably notice a few changes that have taken place, especially the refurbished Harbour Bar and Gaming area. This was well overdue but was delayed due to the shortage of materials and trades people.

A number of other projects have also been delayed because of the same problems.

I am sure you have noticed the closure of some restaurants and other areas of the Club, which has been caused by staff shortages. I have great difficulty understanding how we as a country can have residents of our community not wanting to work.

If you know of any person wanting a position in the hospitality industry, please let them know Twin Towns has positions available.

I could not write a report without including a reference to the passing of H.R.H Queen Elizabeth the Second. Although it was not unexpected, when the notice was released, the world was overwhelmed with grief at the passing of a truly remarkable person, a monarch like we may never see again.

I remember one of the Queen's visits to Australia when I was a young child in school. We were all given flags to wave and taken by bus to line the streets on the route to be taken by the Queen's motorcade.

We all cheered loudly in support of Her Majesty, and I wonder if all us kids really liked the opportunity of seeing the Queen or having a day off from school.

The EGM held in July to determine the changing of the classification of the unusable parcel of land in the centre of the golf course from Core to Non-Core property was passed by a majority of members present.

This will now allow the Club to sell the land to a suitable developer as the Club has no further use for the land which will continue to degrade over time.

The Club has received a proposal from a company named GemLife, who provide over 50's lifestyle living in gated communities.

The company has been given a period of due diligence to carry out their investigations to determine if the site is viable for development and if not, look at other opportunities for the site.

As members will be aware, the Banora masterplan, which includes a proposed shopping complex, is in the process of being developed. It will shortly be lodged with Tweed Shire Council for their consideration. We will wait with bated breath for their determination.

The remainder of the plan, which includes the changes to the bowling greens and tennis courts, as well as the new children's play area, are at this time being further enhanced and improved. This will be provided to members when the designs are finalised.

The Oasis swimming pool has been emptied to allow further inspections to be carried out but the prognosis is not looking good. We are hoping for the best but planning for the worst as it appears the only satisfactory outcome will be a complete rebuild of the pool which has been quoted at around \$12M and will take two years to complete.

The Club cannot commit to the expenditure for what is essentially a community asset. We have approached all levels of Government for financial assistance and we have asked members of the community to assist us by lobbying their local politicians to provide Government funding for the pool.


There is also a petition available on the Club's website for any members of the Club or the community to sign in support of the request.

At this point in time, we have received around 1,200 responses from the community which is a little disappointing. Considering the value of this pool to the community, a lot more responses will be needed before Government will feel they are required to do anything.

This is an opportunity for members to increase their knowledge and understanding of problematic gambling behaviour and recognise when gambling may place them at risk of harm.


It may also be of interest to members who are concerned about
