Last month, Twin Towns Community Foundation answered a call from Tweed-based organisation, Green Heroes, who needed over \$5,000 to purchase underwater cameras for their Jungarra Ngarrian (Cook Island) Conservation Project.

The Conservation Project is led by local Aboriginal youth who wish to care for (sea) country, in particular, Jungarra Ngarrian, which is a place of historical and cultural significance to the local community.

Green Heroes is upscaling the project to include preservation and recovery of local threatened species. In addition, the project brief aims to strengthen the management and preservation of local waters with Traditional Owners as Sea Rangers and the NSW Department of Primary Industries (Aquatic Reserves).

Green Heroes Director & Program Coordinator Sarah Jantos describes the project.

"Divers engage in regular trips to the island to monitor and gather information on flora and fauna species.

"On land, understanding history and culture through art and storytelling creates a deeper connection to Country and builds on community understanding of this land.

"It binds us to it. This is fundamental to creating a desire to preserve and protect these natural spaces and all that lives within them," said Sarah.

Earlier this year, Twin Towns sponsored the Green Heroes Turtle Incubation Program, and through its ClubGRANTS scheme donated \$7,732 to help them conduct a pilot program for the incubation of marine turtle eggs.

The latest donation of \$5,245 to Green Heroes was made through the Twin Towns Services Community Foundation, the Club's philanthropic association set up to provide financial assistance to many local community groups and

READING FOR LIFE THANKS TO TWIN TOWNS

TWIN TOWNS CLUBGRANTS DONATION OF \$10,475 HAS ENABLED LEARNING LINKS TO DELIVER THEIR READING FOR LIFE LITERACY PROGRAM TO 12 CHILDREN IN YEARS 2 TO 4 AT TWEED HEADS PUBLIC SCHOOL.

Learning Links is a not-for-profit organisation with a mission to provide children and young people who have difficulties learning with the skills, services and family support that will enable them to realise their potential. Their Reading for Life program is designed to help kids who are struggling and falling behind at a vital stage of their literacy development.

The children are paired with specially trained 'reading buddies' to support them one-to-one, weekly for 15 weeks, to improve their literacy skills and build their confidence to learn, develop and thrive.

Earlier this year, Twin Towns donated \$8,895 through ClubGRANTS to provide the Learning Links Counting for Life program at Tweed Heads Public School.

This latest donation takes the tally to \$19,370 to facilitate increased learning for local kids, just this year.

Learning Links General Manager of Funding and Partnerships, Don Tilley, said they are so grateful for the partnership with Twin Towns.

"Their commitment to their local community, through funding local charities like Learning Links, is inspiring.

"It enables us to make such a difference to the support we can provide to local children, families and schools who need it the most," said Don.

Deputy Board Chairman and Chair of the Tweed ClubGRANTS Committee, David Phillips, said he and the Board were pleased to assist with the continuation of this revolutionary program at Tweed Public School.

"Twin Towns attempts to help our local community organisations whenever we are able, specifically where the focus is on assisting early education for children.

"We hope this program provides these kids with the tools they need to move forward with confidence in the classroom," said David.


This is an opportunity for members to increase their knowledge and understanding of problematic gambling behaviour and recognise when gambling may place them at risk of harm


It may also be of interest to members who are concerned about a family member or friend who shows signs of problem gambling, especially in relation to gaming machines.
