Last year, Twin Towns extended the final date to redeem Members Advantage Points to New Year's Eve, rather than Christmas Eve.

This year stays the same so members can cash in their points any time up until close of trade on New Year's Eve, Saturday 31 December before the Club reopens for 2023 on 1 January.

There are lots of ways to use them up when you visit the Clubs. Here's how.

- Head to the Pitstop terminal for physical or electronic gift cards or Visa/EFTPOS Gift Cards in many varieties. Use these for Christmas gifts, groceries or to stock up the fridge with your favourite beverages. Minimum card

value is \$50, so you'll need 5,000 points.

- Purchase a Twin Towns gift card in the month of December, valid for up to three years. Minimum card value is \$20 so you'll need 2,000 points. These can be used for food and beverage purchases at the Clubs.
- Spend your points at the Clubs ANYTIME for food, beverages and more.

Now is the time to check your points balance at any point of sale, on the Twin Towns App, at the Kiosks or via the Members Portal on the Twin Towns website.

The most important thing to remember is to redeem this year's points before the end of 2022.

ONLINE MEETING FOR MEMBERS

TWIN TOWNS WILL HOLD ITS FIRST ONLINE INFORMATION SESSION FOR MEMBERS ON MONDAY 5 DECEMBER AT 4PM QLD/5PM NSW TO PROVIDE AN UPDATE ON MATTERS THAT MAY BE OF INTEREST.

This replaces previous sessions conducted with Twin Towns internal club committee members, making the information more readily accessible to all interested members.

Members will have the opportunity to learn more about the redevelopment of Twin Towns Juniors which commences in March, get the latest news on the Club Banora Masterplan including Oasis Pools, and hear about other ongoing matters that may be of interest.

CEO Rob Smith said that in the past, the Club's consultative meetings only reached around 100 internal club committee members from each of the sub-clubs.

"By taking these meetings online, we can communicate with a much broader cross-section of our membership and allow all members, if they choose, to develop a greater understanding of our plans for

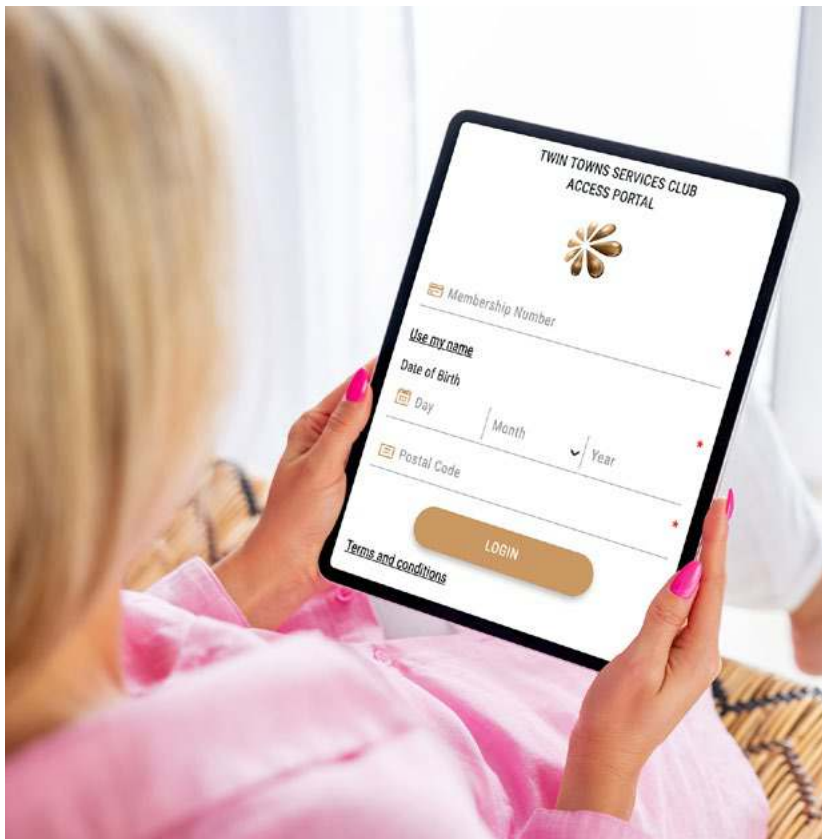
the future and what projects are currently being considered or are underway.





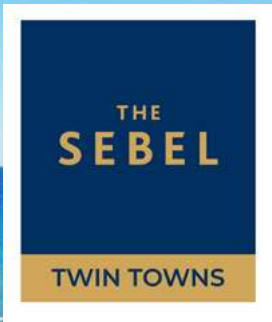
