REMEMBER TO REDEEM YOUR MEMBERS ADVANTAGE POINTS

POINTS EXPIRE 31 DECEMBER

Last year. Twin Towns extended the final date to redeem Members Advantage Points to New Year's Eve, rather than Christmas Eve

This year stays the same so members can cash in their points any time up until close of trade on New Year's Eve, Saturday 31 December, before the Club reopens for 2023 on 1 January.

There are lots of ways to use them up when you visit the Clubs. Here's how:

Head to the Pitstop terminal for physical or electronic gift cards or Visa/EFTPOS Gift Cards in many varieties. Use these for Christmas gifts, groceries or to stock up the fridge with your favourite beverages. Minimum card value is \$50, so you'll need 5,000 points.

Purchase a Twin Towns gift card in the month of December, valid for up to three years. Minimum card value is \$20 so you'll need 2,000 points. These can be used for food and beverage purchases at the Clubs.

Spend your points at the Clubs ANYTIME for food, beverages and more.

Now is the time to check your points balance at any point of sale, on the Twin Towns App, at the Kiosks or via the Members Portal on the Twin Towns website. The most important thing to remember is to redeem this year's points before the end of 2022.

BOARD CHAIRMAN

The past 12 months have gone very quickly but I won't be sorry to see the end of 2022, a year that was very difficult for the entire population.

The effect on Twin Towns Clubs and Resorts was extremely difficult due to the lack of staff, which didn't allow the Clubs to provide our members and visitors with access to all the facilities that are usually available. This included our events space, which is normally booked out at this time of year.

The Clubs are showing an improvement in revenue and visitation which we hope continues leading into Christmas, and we look forward to an improved 2023.

Clubs and hotels are once again under the microscope, this time by State Government, after the much-publicised findings of misconduct into money laundering by Star and Crown Casinos.

The Government set up a crime commission enquiry into money laundering in clubs and pubs through electronic gaming machines. The enquiry found there was a possibility, even with no evidence, that money laundering may be occurring in these venues.

The Government has decided to implement a cashless gaming card that would require members to load the card with funds to play gaming machines. No thought has been given as to how this card would work, nor the cost involved in implementing and monitoring the system, and who will pay for the software required.

The Club takes very seriously the responsibilities placed on their licence to operate gaming machines. The club and gaming machine industry has been conducting trials into the use of cashless cards at clubs on the central coast. These trials only recently commenced and are ongoing.

On Monday 5 December at 4pm Qld (5pm NSW), the Board will hold a meeting with members in a virtual format. This will be the first time we have provided currinformation to members via technology. To access the modern the members' portathe website where a link will provided. I encourage all modes to be part of the audience.

CURTAINS **FOR TYALGUM COMMUNITY HALL**

Fundraising to replace the aging stage curtain at Tyalgum Community Hall was always going to be a tough gig for their small but dedicated committee but thanks to a massive donation from Twin Towns Service Community Foundation, their call for help was answered.

Very few improvements have been made to the stage and dressing room area of the heritage-listed hall since it was built in 1908. The committee's to-do list is a long one, and many projects are out of reach as there is always something more pressing to spend the money on.

Treasurer of the Tyalgum Community Hall Committee, Rona Quayle, said the stage area was desperately in need of renovating for community benefit and to attract the arts community.

"Tyalgum Hall has been internationally recognised as having exceptional acoustics, attracting musicians from all over Australia as a venue for chamber music concerts and performances.

"The annual income from hiring the hall is only just adequate to meet operational and some minor repair costs.

"We are also aware of the unique characteristics of the hall's acoustics and the importance of maintaining its future as a regional venue," said Rona.

Rona reached out to Twin Towns as the committee felt they would understand the importance of having appropriate stage infrastructure to attract cultural and entertainment events.

"Twin Towns' \$18,000 donation has allowed us to achieve a renovation that the community takes



pride in and we look forward to the benefits of the Hall being fully utilised as an arts performance venue.

"It was a wonderful surprise to receive the funding, very unexpected and we are so grateful," said the Treasurer.

Twin Towns Deputy Chairman David Phillips said the Tyalgum Community Hall had more than its fair share of setbacks over the past few years - the impacts of Covid, the floods and subsequent closures of Tyalgum Road further dashed their hopes of fundraising the large amount required for this important project.

We hope all Twin Towns members take immense pride when they visit Tyalgum to see the new red curtains glide open on a concert in this historically significant and muchloved local hall.

"Without our members, there would be no Club, and without their membership and strong support of their Clubs, we would not be in a position to make amazing things happen for financially challenged organisations within the community.

"We were happy Rona and the Tyalgum Community Hall committee reached out to the Foundation for assistance. We send our sincere wishes for a much improved and highly successful 2023 for the Committee and local community," said David.

Ankalaev will enter his first title opportunity on a nine-fight win streak, while Blachowicz earned a win over Aleksandr Rakic in his last outing.


