A BRAND NEW JUNIORS IS COMING MEET YOU THERE SOON!

TWENTY YEARS ON SINCE TWIN TOWNS TOOK OVER JUNIORS AND BREATHED NEW LIFE INTO THE FINANCIALLY STRUGGLING CLUB, A NEW AND EXCITING CHAPTER IS ABOUT TO BEGIN.

It will be out with the old, in with the new when Juniors closes its doors at close of trade on Sunday 2 April.

Demolition works on the old clubhouse will commence from Monday 3 April to make way for the new Juniors which will be built at a cost of \$12M.

Local residents won't be disappointed when they discover what's coming to their own backyard at Tweed Heads South.

Along with contemporary interior design and lighting, natural light-filled spaces, super stylish bar with classic timber features and an outdoor verandah, Juniors will open a new restaurant.

JR's Kitchen is set to become a prime meeting place for locals and families, with dining indoors or outdoors on

the elevated balcony overlooking the playing fields.

Two giant 98 inch screens will be installed in the lounge area, along with smaller screens throughout the Club.

The much-loved outdoor Pavilions will stay as part of the new plan but will be refreshed and outdoor screens and sound upgraded.

The popular outdoor TAB will continue to cater for those who enjoy this space for a beer and a punt.

Twin Towns knows how much locals love their little Club so a plan is already in place to keep members informed throughout the process.

Special Milestone Meetings will be held during the construction phase and members will be invited to attend and stay up to date on how the new Juniors is progressing.

FREE SHUTTLE TO CLUB BANORA

From **Monday 3 April**, a free shuttle service will transport members to and from the Juniors carpark to Club Banora. Here, they'll find most of the familiar faces from Juniors pulling their beers or looking after their needs.

Keep this timetable handy. It may change depending on the popularity of the shuttle service.

Members will find seating and a restroom at the clearly marked bus stop in the existing Juniors carpark.

Remember these changes are only temporary. Before we know it, it will be November 2023 and we will be welcoming an exciting new member to the Twin Towns family of Clubs.





The first couple of months of 2023 were very quiet, considering there were no restrictions on gatherings and no need for social distancing. I hope everybody had a great Christmas and Happy New Year.

The three Clubs are performing really well considering a large number of our members have been impacted by recent interest rate rises and cost of living increases.

The Board and management have tried to limit cost increases in wages, food, beverages and entertainment but unfortunately some costs could not be absorbed and had to be passed onto members.

The large cost increases not only affected our customers but also our building of the new Juniors club which increased enormously but the development will still go ahead as planned.

Demolition and construction will commence in early April and be completed and reopened in November, providing members and visitors with a brand new purpose-built Clubhouse and up-to-date amenities.

I am aware that internal clubs will be holding their AGMs in March. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the committees for their time and dedication that allows the members of those clubs to participate in their chosen recreational activity.

I attempt to attend all the internal AGMs but unfortunately, this year I will be away on a holiday that was only available at that time of year. There will be a member of the Board or Management in attendance to assist if required.

I notice that a few of our long serving committee members are not standing this year. I sincerely thank you for the contribution you have made during your long tenure and I will personally catch up with you on my return.

The Club recently provided members with a new digital update on what was happening around the Clubs. A link was available on the members portal for one month.

The recording was not as easy as I had assumed and I was informed by my wife that I could do with a bit more practice. I just love encouragement.

We will continue with the new format and advise members of the time the recording will be available. I also welcome your feedback on the topics covered or any other issue you would like discussed.

The NSW state election will take place on 25 March 2023 with both major parties making promises about what they can deliver for the residents.

I am sure you have all heard or been made aware of both party's commitments to a cashless gaming system. The leaders talk about how the system will assist with antimoney laundering of cash gained from the proceeds of crime, identified by the crime commission. An integral component of the system is that it will have to include a harm minimisation capability ensuring problem gamblers are able to be excluded from clubs and pubs and will also allow for third party exclusions that can be initiated by their families.

The Industry supports harm minimization initiatives to assist those members of our communities affected by gambling problems, caused by all forms of gambling, not only electronic gaming machines.

The cashless gaming system has not been developed at this point in time so there is no information in relation to how the system will work, the costs involved and who will manage the process.

To simply make a commitment and legislate that into law without any engagement or consultation with manufacturers and peak industry bodies is a recipe for disaster.

Your Club is particularly mindful that we operate in a border environment and could be significantly affected if the clubs and hotels in Qld can continue to operate with cash.

We've taken up this issue with our local member, Geoff Provest, and also the Labor candidate Craig Elliot who have both been very supportive of our concerns. We hope they can influence their parties after one is selected to govern after the election.

The Club already operates a significant responsible gambling program and we stand ready to help where we can before any future technology is introduced.

Celtic Soul, Country Roots, Australian Heart


Asleep at the Reel is a Brisbane-based ensemble who enjoy nothing more than an Irish jig or singalong.


