ANZAC Day on Tuesday 25 April 2023 marks the 108th anniversary of the landings of Australian and New Zealand troops at Gallipoli.

Tweed Heads and Coolangatta RSL Sub-Branch invites the community to attend the Dawn Service and Main Service ceremonies to be conducted at Chris Cunningham Park, Tweed Heads (details below).

"This year, Legacy celebrates 100 years of operation and we are proud to have their members lead our march," said Dr John Griffin, Sub-Branch President.

Also participating in the march will be members of the Coolangatta Country Women's Association, representing those who served in the Australian Women's Land Army.

The AWLA operated between 1942 and 1945 to combat the rising labour shortages in the farming sector due to the male workers joining the armed forces.

"We look forward to seeing thousands of people of all ages at the Services this year, coming together to ensure that the deeds and sacrifices of our veterans and others are honoured and not forgotten," said Dr Griffin.

Parade: Assemble from 10am in Boundary Street. March off

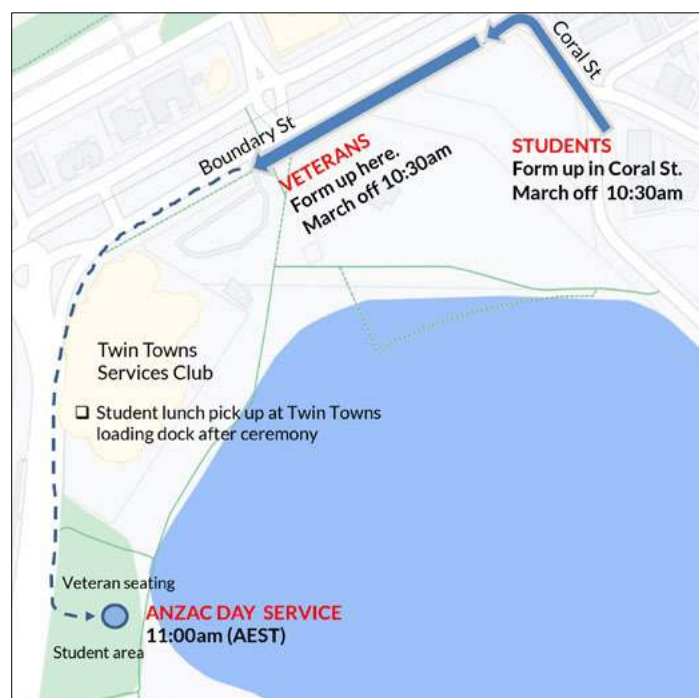

CLUB BANORA IS UNDERGOING A MASSIVE TRANSFORMATION!

TWIN TOWNS HAS DEVELOPED A MASTERPLAN TO REVITALISE THE CLUB TO SUIT THE GROWING NEEDS OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY. THESE PLANS INCLUDE CREATING A NEW CENTRAL VILLAGE FOR BANORA POINT; A VIBRANT AND MODERN RETAIL AND SERVICES HUB WITH SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE.

The masterplan will offer a new supermarket and medical services, and improved Club recreational facilities.

A new lakeside dining area at Club Banora with beautiful green lawns, gardens and outdoor LED screen will become a much-loved meeting place for local residents and families.

The masterplan also includes a new 94-place childcare facility and future potential to add over 50s living.

This redevelopment represents a significant investment at the heart of Banora Point and in the future of the community.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is being proposed at Club Banora?

Club Banora is seeking development approval to redevelop part of the Club's site as a new retail centre, with supermarket, medical centre and allied health services. The development proposal is part of Club Banora's broader masterplan for the site that will include:

- New, lakeside outdoor dining, recreation lawn, playground and outdoor LED screen.
- A new bowling green and two new tennis courts.
- A location for a potential new public swimming pool.
- A new childcare centre on the upper level of the Club building for 94 children, with childcare rooms connecting to a covered outdoor play area.
- Expanded car parking on the Leisure Drive side of the site.
- Landscaping for improved green space and enhanced shade cover.
- Potential future Over 50s Living.

2. Why is Club Banora building a childcare centre?

The Tweed and Banora area has a growing population and is a popular choice for families, increasing demand for childcare.

The new childcare centre will be run by a licenced operator, and while within the Club building, it will have no connection to general members areas. The Club is an existing partner of the childcare provider with a successful facility operating in Tweed Heads.

3. Does the masterplan include a new public swimming pool?

The masterplan provides a location for a potential pool. While a swimming pool is not included in the proposed works, Club Banora is seeking Government funding to provide this service to the local community.

4. Is Seniors / Over 50s Living still included in the plans?

While not currently specified in the masterplan design, Club Banora is still interested in potential future opportunities to provide Seniors Living.

5. How will traffic be managed?

A traffic management plan has been prepared as part of the Development Application. The traffic plan aims to ensure strong, safe pedestrian access to the Club and retail precincts, with two signalised entries to and from the Club and retail onto Leisure Drive.

Twin Towns will contribute to a Council upgrade of the roundabout at the intersection of Leisure and Greenway Drives.

6. When will the redevelopment be delivered?

The first stage of the masterplan redevelopment will be the childcare centre, anticipated to open early 2025 pending development approval. A Development Application is currently under consideration with Tweed Shire Council.

The retail centre, including new supermarket, medical centre and allied health services are expected to open in late 2026, pending development approval. Other Club facility upgrades will be delivered in parallel with these works.

Bottles of Bourbon, Rum, Tequila and Vodka also line the walls of Still & Barrel and if you're into gins, no problem. There's a range of highly sought-after drops from around the world. Cocktails made with quality spirits are also available.

Most of the spirits at Still & Barrel are \$9 per nip but as you'd expect,

the rare and exquisite gems, some of which retail for \$300 to \$400 a bottle, are more expensive.

Gourmet grazing boards with cured meats, cheeses, antipasto and organic breads are available to enjoy with your drinks.

Still & Barrel opens Thursday to Saturday, 8.30pm 'til late. There's live music too with some of Twin Towns most popular soloists and duos.

REBUILDING JUNIORS

From Monday 3 April, Twin Towns Juniors on the corner of Leisure and Fraser Drives, Tweed Heads South, will be temporarily closed.

Demolition works will commence to make way for the new Juniors Club, which will be built at a cost of \$12M.

During the closure, a free shuttle service will transport patrons to and from the Juniors carpark and Club Banora. See right.

Highlights of the new Club will be its contemporary interiors, natural light-filled spaces, a stylish bar and outdoor verandah.

There will also be a new restaurant, JR's Kitchen, with dining indoors or outdoors on an elevated balcony overlooking the playing fields.

The outdoor Pavilions will be refreshed and outdoor screens and sound upgraded. The outdoor TAB will continue to cater for those who enjoy this space for a beer and a punt.

Remember the closure is only temporary. It is anticipated the new Juniors will open its doors in November 2023.



100TH ANNIVERSARY OF MARGARET OLLEY

From 1-30 April, the huge 17 metre screen on the exterior of Twin Towns showcases a selection of beautiful paintings from one of the Tweed Regional Gallery's latest exhibitions, Margaret Olley: Far from a Still Life.

The exhibition tells the story of Olley's incredible life and enduring career through her greatest legacy – her art.

Presented exclusively at the Tweed Regional Gallery, to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Margaret Olley's birthday, the exhibition is drawn entirely from the Tweed Regional Gallery collection.

Far from a Still Life includes artwork from as early as Olley's time at high school in Brisbane through to the final decade of her life; as well as portraits

of Olley and contemporary responses to the re-creation of her famous Duxford Street home studio.

The exhibition takes its title from Meg Stewart's biography Margaret Olley: Far from a Still Life with kind permission from the author and the Margaret Olley Art Trust.

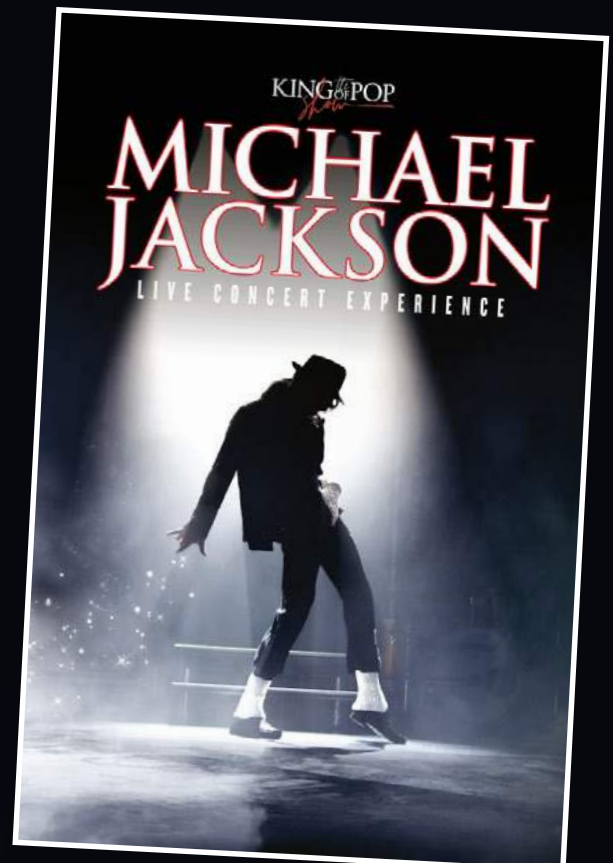
