WITH DONATION FROM TWIN TOWNS

Local community organisation, Shaping Outcomes, has received a \$28,000 helping hand from the Twin Towns Group of Clubs to fund their First Steps program, which provides early childhood intervention supports to children with disabilities and developmental delays.

Twin Towns' donation was part of a joint effort by Clubs of the Tweed, who banded together to come up with the \$55,000 needed by Shaping Outcomes for their program.

As well as Twin Towns \$28,000, South Tweed Sports contributed \$2,000, \$8,000 came from Club Tweed, \$2,000 from Kingscliff Beach Club, \$5,000 from Murwillumbah Services Memorial Club and \$10,000 from Seagulls Club.

The donations will enable Shaping Outcomes to provide Key Worker support packages to local families whose children have experienced a recent diagnosis. The program will equip these families with the tools they need to build emotional resilience and navigate the complex disability sector including NDIS.

Chief Executive Officer of Shaping Outcomes, Colin Usher, said Twin Towns has been an amazing supporter of Shaping Outcomes for the past four decades.

"With the help of the ClubGRANTS and Twin Towns, we have been able to supply ongoing Early Childhood Development supports for local children and families.

"The 40-plus year relationship has also helped fund the building of offices, teaching and therapy rooms in our Florence Street facility.

"This most recent grant will help us provide services to over 50 children in our region that have fallen through the gaps in the health, education and disability sectors.

"We could not provide these vital services to families in our region without Twin Towns.

"We are stronger together!"

Twin Towns Deputy Chairman David Phillips said it was gratifying to see the

outstanding achievements of Shaping Outcomes as a result of their long-term relationship with Twin Towns.

"We hope members are proud that their Club has provided more than \$300,000 in funding to local community organisations over the past 12 months.

"Without the strong support of our members, we would not be in a position to make amazing things happen for financially challenged organisations within the community such as Shaping Outcomes.

"On behalf of the Board, I send our sincere wishes to Shaping Outcomes for a highly successful roll-out of their latest program for local kids," said David.






















PSEUDO ECHO

No need to register for the Bowls Open Day, just come and have some fun. There will be morning tea after bowls.




Club Banora is the perfect place to chill outdoors with a few drinks, where you can gather a group of family or friends, and the kids have a huge playground to keep them entertained for hours.
