From Little Malaya to Jr's at Juniors

Many regular diners at Juniors have done a 'double take' after recognising Chinese chef Justin Li from his nine years working at Little Malaya restaurants, first at Coolangatta and then Tweed Heads.

"People have told me they're happy to see me working at Jr's because they remember me from my previous job," said Justin.

Justin works alongside chef, John Chen, preparing Jr's Modern Asian dishes.

"The restaurant is going really well and we're finding many locals are quickly becoming regular faces," he said.

Two of the biggest sellers on the Asian menu are both Thai - slow-cooked Massaman beef brisket with coconut cream, chilli and lime rice and the King Prawn Pad Thai rice noodles in peanut, tamarind and sweet soy sauce.

The Chinese Beef with garlic sauce and vegetables rounds off the top three.

Justin has been working on

some new Malaysian dishes to introduce to the menu further down the track.

"The food that I will try to bring in is mostly Malaysian as I know people really enjoy it.

"I've been trialling some of my favourites from previous years on the specials board to see how they go.

"If they are popular, we will move them to the main menu as time goes on," said Justin.

Since opening, Jr's Kitchen has received many requests for vegetarian and gluten-free dishes.

Chefs have adapted some of the existing dishes to increase these options and there is now a stir fry with seasonal vegetables and garlic sauce and vegetarian Singapore Noodles.

There are more vegetarian and gluten-free dishes on both the Asian and bistro-style menu.

Twin Towns Services Community Foundation members welcomed over 200 children with special needs and their families to a free Kids Party in the Showroom late last year.

The Board was honoured to have former Board Director, Founding Member of the Foundation and Life Member of Twin Towns, Ron Lewis, attend as their special guest.

Ron was instrumental in creating the Foundation's inaugural Kids Party which began as a fireworks night in Stars. The expansive glass on Level 5 provided a 'no noise' platform where kids with special needs could feel safe and enjoy the experience.

At the time, Ron knocked on doors of many local community organisations and schools that catered for special needs, searching for children who would enjoy the opportunity to come to the Kids Party. He found no shortage of takers!

In 2005, the event became a Kids Party in the Showroom.

Ron managed the Kids Party up until

his retirement, when other Foundation Members took over. It has remained an annual event, apart from a few years' hiatus due to Covid in 2020 and 2021 and the floods in 2022.

In 2023, however, Kids Day lived up to the hype of years gone by with non-stop party food and drinks, jumping castle, facepainting, balloon artist, photo booth and a generous helping of party atmosphere.

chat with other parents while the kids were entertained.

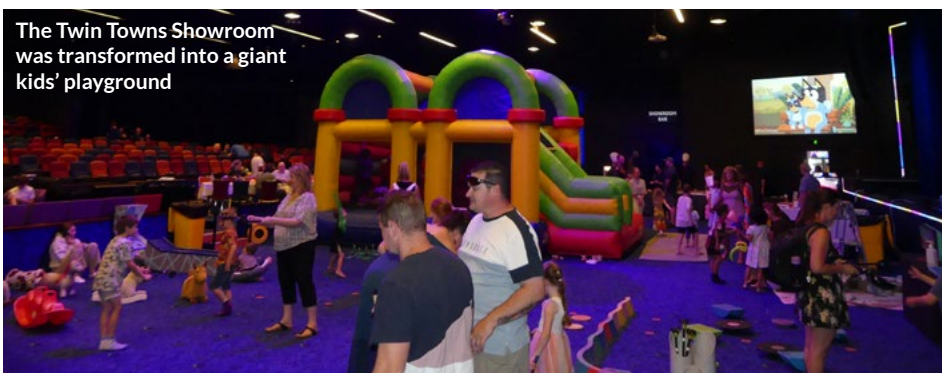
"Everyone loved the entertainment, the food was a dream come true for the kids and it was wonderful that both children and adults were catered for.

The flavour of the month is DUCK

Harbour Fresh chefs will showcase their impressive culinary skills throughout January with a changing daily selection of two delicious duck dishes, colourfully complemented by some of the freshest and finest local produce from the Northern Rivers.

To add another layer of flavour to some of their duck dishes, chefs will be making the most of the smoker you may have seen in action on weekends at the Harbour Terrace Balcony.

Duck smoked inhouse will feature in many of the lighter lunch dishes planned for the month. One of these is the five spiced crispy skin duck with mango, pomegranate and water cress, pictured below left.

To create this dish, chefs soak the duck overnight in a brine of orange and local honey before it is smoked for three hours at

70 degrees celsius. Prior to serving, it is cooked again for another 30 minutes, also at 70 degrees, until it's the perfect shade of blush pink.

There is also a tea-smoked duck breast with apple, honey and mint slaw and smoked duck breast with orange, Persian goat fetta and walnut salad on the lunch menu.

Another one to keep an eye out for is the Confit Duck Leg, pictured below right.

For this classic French dish, the duck is cured overnight in salt, then slow-cooked at low temperature in its own fat for around

two and a half hours. Prior to serving, it's briefly cooked at high temperature to develop the thin and crispy skin that makes this duck dish so delectable.

The confit duck is served with roasted carrot puree, grilled figs and sticky balsamic glaze.

Some other dishes planned for the dinner menu are duck croquette with blood orange and slow-cooked duck breast with charred stone fruits.

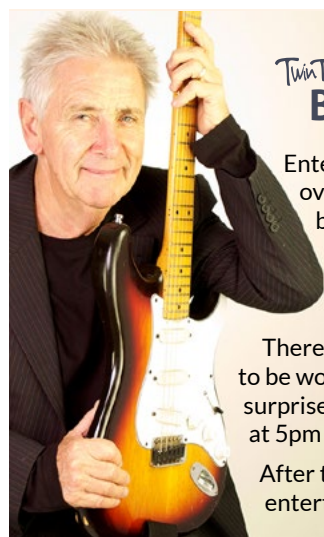

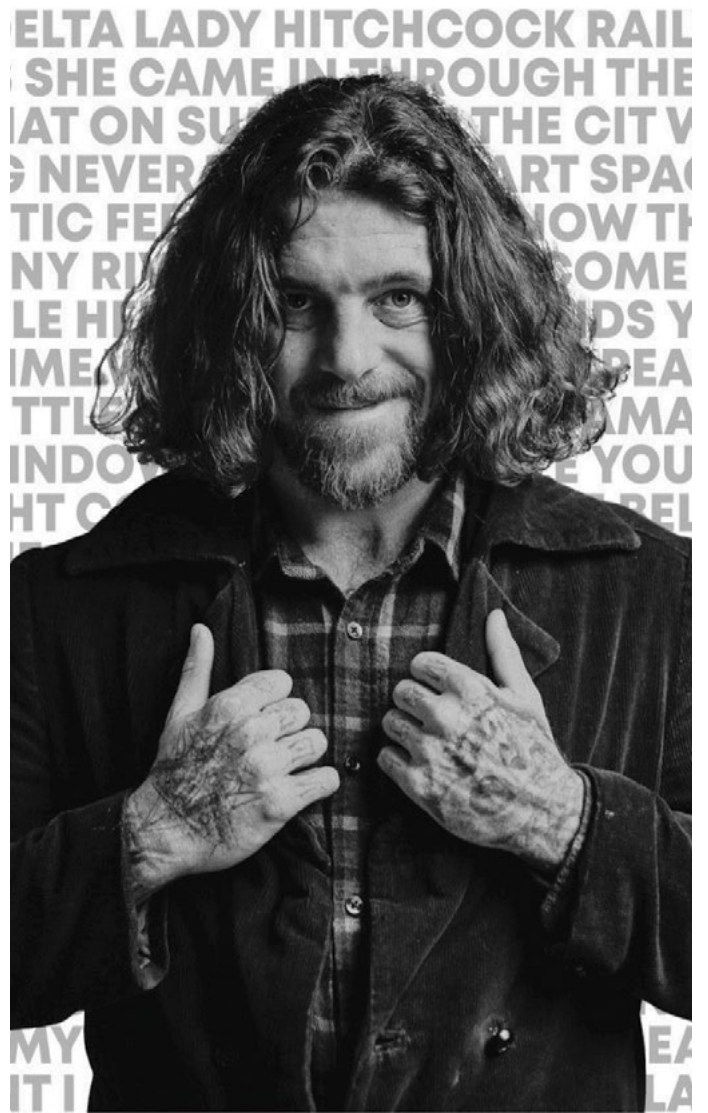

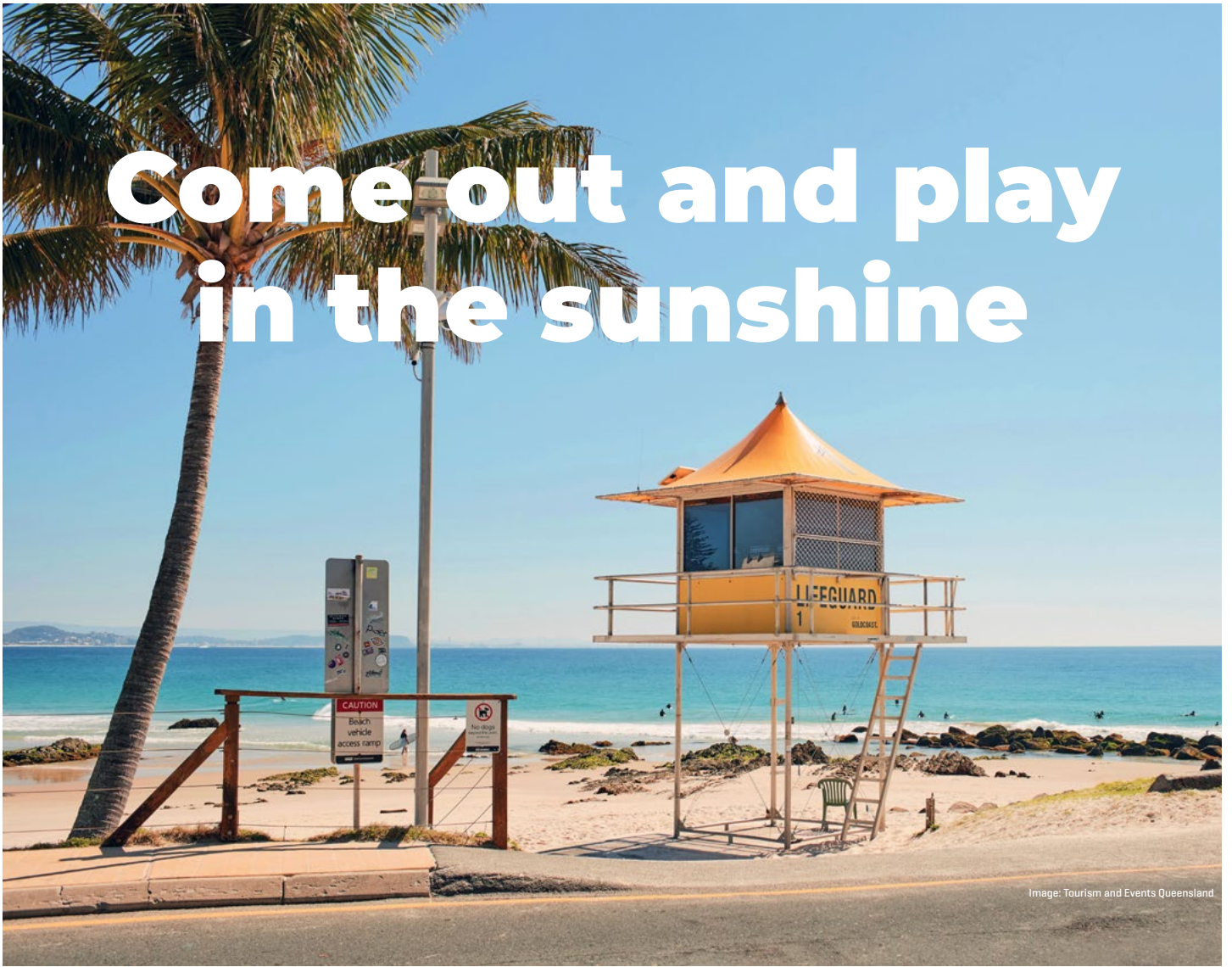
