ANZAC DAY 2024 AT TWIN TOWNS

ANZAC Day on Thursday 25 April 2024 marks the 109th anniversary of the landings of Australian and New Zealand troops at Gallipoli.

Thursday 25 April in Chris Cunningham Park, Tweed Heads NSW.

ORDER OF DRESS

Members are requested to wear a shirt with collar, long pants and medals, coat optional.

DAWN SERVICE

Assemble at 5.45am on the road in Wharf Street near the children statue. The short March will be into the park with the service commencing at 5.55am.

Breakfast after the Dawn Service must be pre-booked at a cost of \$5. The breakfast package includes an Andrews Sisters Tribute Concert in the Showroom. See ANZAC Day packages on next page.

MAIN SERVICE

KO's, COMEBACKS AND SURPRISES ON A STACKED UFC CARD

Hailed as the greatest night of fights ever assembled, don't miss a noment of UFC 300, live at 1st on Wharf Tavern, Club Banora and Twin Towns Juniors on Sunday 14 April.

The main event sees the return of Brazil's two-division UFC champion Alex Pereira, defending his light heavyweight title against American former champion, Jamahal Hill.

Pereira, 36, stopped Jiri Prochazka via TKO to win the belt at UFC 295 last November. The previous year, he knocked out Israel Adesanya to win the middleweight title before dropping the belt back to Adesanya last April.

Hill (12-1, 1 NC) has been out of the ring due to a torn Achilles tendon. He never lost the light heavyweight title but relinquished the belt last summer due to the injury.

The 32-year-old Chicago native has won four straight, beating Glover Teixeira to win the title in January 2023.

Pereira vs Hill is just one of the must-sees on the stacked card. It also features 12 current or former champions, a former two-time Olympic gold medallist and a standout college wrestler.

Another highlight will be an all-China throwdown between women's strawweight champion Weili Zhang and Yan Xiaonan. Zhang earned her title back after a throttling of Carla Esparza. She has defended it once since against Amanda Lemos last August.

Xiaonan, meanwhile, earned the opportunity thanks to a TKO of Jessica Andrade last May.
